Summary: The Arroyo Seco Neighborhood Council (ASNC) extends its support to this motion (21-0002-s30) calling to and supporting federal legislation that would provide funds for fare free public transportation. Reliable and affordable public transit supports our general economy, helps reduce car reliance, and clears our air. Transit fares are often burdens on those that can least afford it, and COVID-19 has led to service cuts at a time when people can least afford alternative transportation. Enforcement of transit fares can lead to unnecessary conflicts between armed officers and Black and Brown members of our City. The Arroyo Seco NC supports this effort and calls on the City of Los Angeles to continue this advocacy on the state level as well as pushing for this policy with the Metro Board, including Mayor Garcetti, the current Chair.
