Summary: We, the Atwater Village Neighborhood Council, are requesting that you support Council File 21-0031. For months, local activists and our unhoused neighbors have called out the violence of “sweeps,” also known as CARE and CARE+ operations. During COVID-19 especially, these protocols increase the risk of infection among our most vulnerable populations. The motion put forth by councilmembers Bonin and Raman presents a much more humane alternative that actually aims to provide services to those experiencing homelessness, and the city council should support it wholly.
