

AD HOC ON COVID-19 RECOVERY AND NEIGHBORHOOD INVESTMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to resources needed to process and pay all outstanding Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) applications.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (De León - Cedillo - Rodriguez):

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Housing Department to:

- a. Develop a robust, multi-lingual outreach campaign to directly engage Angelinos who did not submit applications in April and who do not have easy access to a digital device or face other barriers to completing an application.
- b. Report within 10 days on the funding allocated to the Eviction Defense Program, when the program will be fully operational, and how the public will be able to know about and access the program.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY:

At a special meeting held on August 24, 2021, the Ad Hoc on COVID-19 Recovery and Neighborhood Investment Committee considered Motion (De León - Cedillo - Rodriguez) relative to resources needed to process and pay all outstanding ERAP applications.

During the discussion, the Committee Chair offered an amendment for consideration by the members to strike the first three bullet points in the Motion, as reflected above.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended approving the Motion as amended. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
