Summary: The Greater Valley Glen Council supports efforts to identify sites within the City that are suitable for possible construction of temporary or permanent housing for our City's homeless as enumerated in CF 21-0063, but take exception to the possible use of neighborhood parks for such purposes. Our City lacks parks that are easily accessible to many of its citizens. The Department of Recreation and Parks needs to concentrate on its mission to enrich the lives of the residents of Los Angeles by providing safe, welcoming parks and recreation facilities and affordable, diverse recreation and human services activities for people of all ages to play, learn, contemplate, build community and be good stewards of our environment. Neighborhood parks should remain neighborhood parks and parcels under its control should remain developable as neighborhood or pocket parks.
