Summary: The Hollywood United Neighborhood Council is writing in support of CF 21-0073, as introduced by CM Raman. Proper sanitation is critical to creating a healthy environment for every member of our city, and greater access to trash disposal will benefit both housed and unhoused residents. Many encampment residents have expressed their desire to NC members for these services. We strongly urge city council to pass this file and increase trash cans at encampments. That said, we recognize even the best intentioned ideas may need caveats to ensure their goal is realized. We would offer the following suggestions when implementing these new bins: Bins should be labeled, entered into 311 system, and CD's and NCs should be notified. Bins should be maintained and serviced at least once a week. Currently trash sits at encampments for 3+ weeks which only makes these issues worse (and is evidence of this need). We recommend legislation and signage regarding prohibition of bulk dump at the location A tent should either be required to be x feet away from the basket to be able to safely determine trash over private property OR There needs to be legislation and signage that with x diameter of the bin, it will be considered trash and will be disposed of accordingly. The City needs to be equally if not more concerned with bulk dump component, and in the prevention of storage of trash/bulk dump in street where it takes up parking and prevent save driving and turning
