

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to amending the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) to expedite administrative processes and time for a parking facility to be ready for use as a safe haven by those experiencing homelessness.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated June 2, 2021, amending Article 4, Chapter 20, Section 22.483 of the LAAC to grant sole authority to the General Manager of the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) to determine the rates, maximum legal parking time, and the hours of operation of a LADOT controlled off-street parking facility when approved and funded by the City Council for use as a Safe Parking program, or any other homeless program or project.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY:

At a regular meeting held on June 24, 2021, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered a City Attorney report and draft Ordinance relative to amending the LAAC to expedite administrative processes and time for a parking facility to be ready for use as a safe haven by those experiencing homelessness. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve on consent the City Attorney report and adopt the draft Ordinance. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
