Summary: Whereas, the pandemic continues to pose serious health risks to LA's unhoused populations. Whereas, non-congregate housing is essential to controlling the spread of the virus among unhoused populations and protecting overall community health. Whereas, the County of LA, through project roomkey, provides temporary shelter to unhoused people 65 and older or with health risks or co-morbidities. Whereas, hotel and motel occupancy rates remain well below normal levels and tourism will take time to recover to pre-pandemic levels. Whereas, President Biden's recent executive order makes costs for non-congregate housing 100% reimbursable by FEMA, enabling municipalities to extend temporary shelter protections for unhoused populations, while providing much-needed revenue to struggling hotels and motels. Therefore, the Del Rey Neighborhood Council supports Councilmembers Bonin and Raman's January 26, 2021 motion CF 21-0113.
