Summary: We, the South Robertson Neighborhoods Council, SUPPORT the motion to re-launch Project Roomkey considering the budgetary concerns which discontinued the program are no longer relevant. Project Roomkey represents a massive opportunity to place unhoused people into government care and into temporary housing that is safe during the COVID-19 pandemic. The City should still request reimbursement for Project Roomkey costs incurred prior to the FEMA announcement, and should pursue state funding in order to front the money.
