SUBJECT:

Approve the Third Amendment to Contract DA-5243 with General Dynamics Information Technology Inc., to add language regarding security requirements and add the Funding Cost Accounts, as per the Federal and the Department of Homeland Security requirements.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Management RECOMMENDS that the Board of Airport Commissioners:

- ADOPT the Staff Report.
- DETERMINE that this action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article II, Section 2.f of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
- APPROVE the Third Amendment to Contract DA-5243 with General Dynamics Information Technology Inc., adding the language "The Contractor shall comply with Federal Acquisition Regulation Clause 52.204-2 Security Requirements for the remainder of the contract", and the Funding Cost Center 1160032 and Cost Element 520900 to the contract.
- AUTHORIZE the Chief Executive Officer to execute said Amendment after approval as to form by the City Attorney and approval by the Los Angeles City Council.

DISCUSSION:

1. Purpose

Approve adding the language “The Contractor shall comply with Federal Acquisition Regulation Clause 52.204-2 Security Requirements for the remainder of the contract”, and the Funding Cost Account number 1160032 and Cost Element number 520900 to the contract of General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc.

Inclusion of Federal Acquisition Regulation Clause 52.204-2 language and Funding Cost Accounts are new federal requirements for all Directive Division 254 classified contracts.

2. Prior Related Actions

- **On July 5, 2016**, a Service Authority (470001266) was established with SRA International with a contract start date of 6/19/2016 for Intelligence analyst services for Airport Police Division’s Homeland Security to provide analysis on aviation specific threats.
- **On August 18, 2016** (Resolution No. 26053) the Board of Airport Commissioners authorized Los Angeles World Airports to re-join County of Los Angeles Contract 77775 with SRA International, Inc. for intelligence analyst services for Los Angeles World Airports, Airport Police Division from date of execution until June 18, 2017.
- **On October 5, 2017 - Resolution 26350** (DA-5243) the Board of Airport Commissioners authorized Los Angeles World Airports awarded a 3-year contract to SRA International, Inc. for intelligence analyst services from date of December 1, 2017 until November 30, 2020.
- **On February 21, 2019 - Resolution 26704** (DA-5243A) the Board of Airport Commissioners authorized the First Amendment to adjust the hourly rate per intelligence analyst and expanded the scope of services.
- **On November 19, 2020 - Resolution 27136** (DA-5243B) the Board of Airport Commissioners approved the Assignment and Assumption of, and Second Amendment to Contract DA-5243 to extend the term through November 30, 2021, covering intelligence analyst services for Los Angeles Airports, Airport Police Division and SRA having merged with General Dynamics Information Technology Inc.

3. Current Action

Staff proposes a Third Amendment to the contract to add language “The Contractor shall comply with Federal Acquisition Regulation Clause 52.204-2 Security Requirements for the remainder of the contract” and the Cost Account 1160032 and Cost Element 520900 to the contract of General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc.

LAWA’s Airport Police Department is responsible for the overall protection and security of LAWAS two airports (LAX and VNY), including policing, security and counterterrorism functions. The Airport Police Departments utilizes the contract with General Dynamics

Information Technology, Inc. to obtain daily Intelligence Analyst consulting services that are needed to gain access to multiple databases, reports, systems and other information that can be used to identify and assess potential security threats for our airports. With the growing occurrence of terrorists acts throughout the country and world, it has become necessary to take a more proactive approach in establishing relationships with allied agencies to facilitate information sharing and to synthesize intelligence specifically for LAX and VNY.

Inclusion of Federal Acquisition Regulation Clause 52.204-2 language and Funding Cost Accounts are new federal requirements for all Directive Division 254 classified contracts that involve access to Intelligence Data, such as our contract with General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc.

How this action advances a specific strategic plan goal and objective

This action advances this strategic goal and objective: *Innovate to Enhance Security, Efficiency & Effectiveness: Innovate to keep airports safe and secure.* To provide Intelligence Analyst Services for analysis of aviation specific threats for Airport Police Division (APD), Homeland Security Services. The impact of not maintaining these services will leave LAWA vulnerable to an increased threat of terrorist activity.

Action Requested

- Staff requests the approval of the third amendment to the contract to add language “The Contractor shall comply with Federal Acquisition Regulation Clause 52.204-2 Security Requirements for the remainder of the contract”, and the Funding Cost Account 1160032 and Cost Element 520900 to the contract of General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc.

Fiscal Impact

The costs incurred under this contract will be recovered through landing fees and terminal rates and charges, as well as through non-aeronautical revenues.

4. Alternatives Considered

- ***None***

The services from the intelligence analysts are valuable and have proven to be a great benefit in keeping LAWA safe and secure. The analysts have collaborated with a variety of agencies in Southern California, giving them access to multiple databases, reports, and systems. Thereby they have been able to brief and advise management on current threat issues and make recommendations on changes to programs that are in place to help keep LAX safe from external threats.

APPROPRIATIONS:

Funds for this contract are available in the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 LAWA Operating Budget in LAX Cost Center 1160032 – Homeland Security Section, Commitment Item 520 – Contractual Services. Funding for subsequent fiscal years will be requested through the annual budget process.

STANDARD PROVISIONS:

1. This item, as a continuing administrative, maintenance and personnel-related activity, is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article II, Section 2.f of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
2. This item is subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.
3. Actions taken on this item by the Board of Airport Commissioners will become final pursuant to the provisions of Los Angeles City Charter Section 373.
4. General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. will comply with the provisions of the Ordinance.
5. Procurement Services has reviewed this action (File No. 10042566). No mandatory Small Business Enterprise, Local Business Enterprise/Local Small Business Enterprise, and Disabled Veterans goals were set for this project, as no subcontracting opportunities were identified.
6. General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. will comply with the provisions of the Affirmative Action Program.
7. General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. has been assigned Business Tax Registration Certificate number 0002740370-0001 -1.
8. General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. will comply with the provisions of the Child Support Obligations Ordinance.
9. General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. must have approved insurance documents, in the terms and amounts required, on file with Los Angeles World Airports prior to contract amendment.
10. Pursuant to Charter Section 1022, staff determined the work specified on the proposed contract can be performed more feasibly or economically by an Independent Contractor than by City employees.
11. General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. has submitted the Contractor Responsibility Program Questionnaire and Pledge of Compliance and will comply with the provisions of the Contractor Responsibility Program.
12. General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. must be determined by Public Works, Office of Contract Compliance to be in full compliance with the provisions of the Equal Benefits Ordinance prior to execution of the amendment.
13. General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. will comply with the provisions of the First Source Hiring Program for all non-trade Airport jobs.
14. General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. has submitted the Bidder Contributions CEC Form 55 and will comply with its provisions.
15. General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. has submitted the Municipal Lobbying Ordinance CEC form 50 and will comply with its provisions.
16. This action is not subject to the provisions of the Iran Contracting Act of 2010.
