

Subject: **PROPOSED THIRD AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT DA-5243 WITH GENERAL DYNAMICS INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, INC.**

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Mayor:

1. Approve a proposed Third Amendment to Contract DA-5243 with General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. to include language specific to the Federal Acquisition Regulation Clause 52.204-2 regarding security requirements, and add Funding Cost Account 1160032 and Cost Element 520900, in compliance with Federal and Department of Homeland Security requirements, subject to City Attorney approval as to form and compliance with the City's Standard Provisions, including: Living Wage Ordinance, Affirmative Action Program, Business Tax Registration Certification, Child Support Obligations Ordinance, Charter Section 1022, Contractor Responsibility Program, First Source Hiring Program, Bidder Contributions City Ethics Commission Form 55, and Municipal Lobbying Ordinance City Ethics Commission Form 50;
2. Authorize the Chief Executive Officer to execute the proposed Third Amendment upon approval by the Los Angeles City Council, and prior to execution, General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. must:
 - a. Be determined by Public Works, Office of Contract Compliance to be in full compliance with the provisions of the Equal Benefits Ordinance; and
 - b. Have approved insurance documents, in the terms and amounts required, on file with the Los Angeles World Airports; and
3. Return the request to the Los Angeles World Airports for further processing, including Council consideration.

SUMMARY

The Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) Board of Airport Commissioners (BOAC) requests approval of a proposed Third Amendment to Contract DA-5243 with General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. to add the following language: “The Contractor shall comply with Federal Acquisition Regulation Clause 52.204-2 Security Requirements for the remainder of the contract.” The proposed Third Amendment also adds Funding Cost Account 1160032 and Cost Element 520900 to Contract DA-5243. The inclusion of the Federal Acquisition Regulation Clause 52.204-2 language and Funding Cost Account information are new federal requirements for all Directive Division 254 classified contracts that involve access to intelligence data.

LAWA's Airport Police is responsible for the overall security at Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) and Van Nuys Airport (VNY), including policing, security, and counterterrorism functions. The Airport Police Department utilizes the contract with General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. to obtain daily intelligence analyst consulting services that are needed to gain access to multiple databases, reports, systems and other information that can be used to identify and assess potential security threats at both airports. LAWA indicates that the growing occurrence of terrorist acts throughout the country and the world have made it necessary to take a more proactive approach in establishing relationships with allied agencies to facilitate information sharing, and to synthesize intelligence specifically for LAX and VNY.

In November 2020, the BOAC approved the Assignment and Assumption from SRA International to General Dynamics Information Technology, and Second Amendment to Contract DA-5243, to extend the term through November 30, 2021.

The BOAC approved the proposed Third Amendment at its meeting on May 6, 2021. Actions taken on this item by the BOAC will become final pursuant to the provisions of Los Angeles City Charter Section 373.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

Approval of the proposed Third Amendment to Contract DA-5243 with General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. to include language specific to the Federal Acquisition Regulation Clause 52.204-2 regarding security requirements, and add Funding Cost Account 1160032 and Cost Element 520900, will have no impact on the General Fund. Funds for this contract are available in the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 LAWA Operating Budget in LAX Cost Center 1160032 – Homeland Security Section, Commitment Item 520 – Contractual Services. Funding for subsequent fiscal years will be requested through the annual budget process. The proposed Third Amendment complies with LAWA's Financial Policies.
