WHEREAS, on recommendation of Management, there was presented for approval, Third Amendment to Contract DA-5243 with General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. to add language regarding security requirements and add the funding cost accounts, as per the Federal and the Department of Homeland Security requirements, covering intelligence analyst services for Los Angeles World Airports; and

WHEREAS, Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) Airport Police Division (APD) is responsible for overall protection and security of LAWA's two (2) airports, Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) and Van Nuys Airport (VNY), including policing, security and counterterrorism functions. APD utilizes the contract with General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. to obtain daily Intelligence Analyst consulting services that are needed to gain access to multiple databases, reports, systems and other information that can be used to identify and assess potential security threats for the airports. With the growing occurrence of terrorists acts throughout the country and world, it has become necessary to take a more proactive approach in establishing relationships with allied agencies to facilitate information sharing and to synthesize intelligence specifically for LAX and VNY; and

WHEREAS, inclusion of Federal Acquisition Regulation Clause 52.204-2 language and funding cost accounts are new federal requirements for all Directive Division 254 classified contracts that involve access to intelligence data, such as the contract with General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Third Amendment will add the language "The Contractor shall comply with Federal Acquisition Regulation Clause 52.204-2 Security Requirements for the remainder of the contract" and include Cost Account 1160032 and Cost Element 520900 to the contract with General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, funds for the contract are available in the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 LAWA Operating Budget in LAX Cost Center 1160032 – Homeland Security Section, Commitment Item 520 – Contractual Services. Funding for subsequent fiscal years will be requested through the annual budget process; and

WHEREAS, this item, as a continuing administrative, maintenance and personnel-related activity, is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article II, Section 2.f. of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. will comply with the provisions of the Affirmative Action Program and Child Support Obligations Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. has been assigned Business Tax Registration Certificate 0002740370-0001-1; and

WHEREAS, General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. must have approved insurance documents, in the terms and amounts required, on file with LAWA prior to contract amendment; and



WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter Section 1022, staff determined that the work specified on the contract can be performed more feasibly or economically by an Independent Contractor than by City employees; and

WHEREAS, General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. has submitted the Contractor Responsibility Program Questionnaire and Pledge of Compliance, and will comply with the provisions of said program; and

WHEREAS, General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. must be determined by Public Works, Office of Contract Compliance to be in full compliance with the provisions of the Equal Benefits Ordinance prior to execution of the amendment; and

WHEREAS, General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. will comply with the provisions of the First Source Hiring Program for all non-trade airport jobs; and

WHEREAS, General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. has submitted the Bidder Contributions CEC Form 55, and will comply with its provisions; and

WHEREAS, General Dynamics Information Technology, Inc. has submitted the Municipal Lobbying Ordinance CEC form 50, and will comply with its provisions; and

WHEREAS, actions taken on this item by the Board of Airport Commissioners will become final pursuant to the provisions of Los Angeles City Charter Section 373;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Airport Commissioners adopted the Staff Report; determined that this action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article II, Section 2.f. of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines; approved the Third Amendment to Contract DA-5243 with General Dynamics Information Technology Inc. to add language regarding security requirements and add the funding cost accounts, as per the Federal and the Department of Homeland Security requirements, covering intelligence analyst services for Los Angeles World Airports; and authorized the Chief Executive Officer to execute said Third Amendment to Contract DA-5243 with General Dynamics Information Technology Inc. after approval as to form by the City Attorney and approval by the Los Angeles City Council.
