Summary: Mid-City Neighborhood Council is opposed to having the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment to be responsible for the Olivia Mitchell Youth Council. DONE does not currently have the bandwidth, staffing, or funding to take on another project because of budget and staffing cuts. DONE cannot currently provide the support to the Neighborhood Council System it is mandated by City Charter to do. The Youth Council has always been under the guidance of the Mayor's Office, which provided staffing support and funding. If the City Council wants to have a Youth Council of their own, then the City Council should provide their own funding and staffing to support their own Youth Council or a separate city department for the Youth Council, such as the proposed Youth Development Department, and sufficiently fund the department. Furthermore, Mid-City Neighborhood Council demands that the City Council eliminate gender binary language to include language that recognizes that gender is a spectrum.
