#### SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on February 25, 2021, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered a CAO report, dated February 24, 2021, relative to a status update on the Memorandum of Understanding between the City and County of Los Angeles/Covid-19 Homelessness Roadmap. A Representative from the CAO's office presented and provided details on the matter, and answered questions from the Committee members. Some of the comments and questions originating from members included concerns about possibly missing a key deadline of April 16, 2021, with respect to this process. Also there was interest in learning of projects that are behind; which Council Districts have projects that are behind; and, reasons the projects may be behind. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to note and file the CAO's reports. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
