The Sun Valley Area Neighborhood Council, SVANC, in its regular meeting of August 10, 2021, passed the following Community Impact Statement by a vote of: 11 yes, 0 no, and 0 abstained.

The Sun Valley Area Neighborhood Council supports the Cultural Heritage Commission (CHC) decision to nominate Studio City Golf and Tennis Club located at 4141 Whitsett Ave., Studio City, CA 91604 to be included in the list of Historic-Cultural Monuments. The CHC determined that the entire subject property conforms with the definition of a Monument under Section 22.171.7 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code. The Commission also voted to change the proposed monument's name back to "Studio City Golf and Tennis Club" to reflect the original, historic name.
