

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a establishing a fee based inspection program of R1/R2 Properties sufficient to cover the costs of the state-mandated inspections.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. REQUEST the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) to conduct a fee study to establish a fee structure for the R1/R2 Inspection Program.
2. REQUEST the City Attorney, with the assistance of the LAFD, to prepare and present a draft ordinance to establish a fee for the inspection of R1/R2 properties.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Fire Commissioners. Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held June 2, 2021 the Public Safety Committee virtually considered a Board of Fire Commissioners report relative to a establishing a fee based inspection program of R1/R2 Properties sufficient to cover the costs of the state-mandated inspections. After providing an opportunity for public comment, representatives from the LAFD made a brief presentation to the Committee on the subject matter and the Chair provided amendments to the recommendations in the BOFC report dated May 4, 2021. The Committee approved the recommendations verbally amended by the Chair, as detailed above. This matter is now transmitted to Council for its consideration.
