

ARTS, PARKS, HEALTH, EDUCATION, AND NEIGHBORHOODS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the 2021 Dodgers RBI Program Grant (Grant) from the Los Angeles Dodgers Foundation (LADF), for youth baseball and girls softball leagues for the 2021 Season.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the General Manager, Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP), or designee to accept and receive the 2021 Grant from the LADF consisting of grant funds in the amount of \$148,680 and in-kind contributions of, uniforms, equipment, training, and other items with an estimated value of 212,584, in support of RAP's operation of the Dodgers Reviving Baseball in Inner Cities Program (RBI) 2021 Season, for the benefit of youth ages 5-15, as further detailed in Report No. 21-085, attached to the Council file.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners reports that the Grant provides funding, uniforms, equipment, and in-kind contributions valued at an estimated amount of \$361,264 from LADF in connection with the 2021 RBI Program. Acceptance of this Grant has no fiscal impact on RAP's General Fund, as all funding for the Grant is being provided by LADF, at no cost to RAP, for the benefit of participating youth in the 2021 RBI Program at the 19 Recreation Centers.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

At its meeting on June 22, 2021, the Arts, Parks, Health, Education, and Neighborhoods Committee considered the May 20, 2021 Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners report relative to the 2021 Grant from the LADF, for youth baseball and girls softball leagues for the 2021 Season.
