Dear Mr. Mizan,

The Bel Air-Beverly Crest Neighborhood Council has considered the street vacation and gating project proposed by the Bel Air Glen Homeowners Association.

The Planning and Land Use Committee held a public hearing on the issue on January 11, 2022, after which it created a task force to hold meetings with opponents and proponents of the project and to make a recommendation. On May 10, 2022 the Planning and Land Use Committee met, and after hearing public testimony, considered a letter recommending denial of the proposal from the task force. The committee then voted to postpone consideration of the item for three months at the request of the applicant so the applicant could develop alternative proposals to the street vacation. The committee then met on August 9, 2022 and after hearing an alternative proposal from the applicant and conducting a public hearing voted to recommend denial of the project to the Board.
