

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to authority to negotiate and execute a First Amendment to the professional services agreement with the Los Angeles Police Revolver and Athletic Club, Inc. to extend the term of the contract an additional four years through July 23, 2024; the proposed amendment will remain a no-cost contract..

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Chief, Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), or designee, to execute the First Amendment to Contract No. C-133545, an agreement between the City and the Los Angeles Police Revolver and Athletic Club, Inc., to provide officers the opportunity to utilize the Elysian Park Police Academy ranges during the dates and times the ranges are not in use by the LAPD, for a term of four years beginning July 24, 2020 through July 23, 2024, with no cost to the City, subject to the review and approval of the City Attorney as to form.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that approval of the recommendation in this report will have no impact to the General Fund as the proposed amendment is for a no-cost contract.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the recommendation in this report complies with the City's Financial Policies in that no funding is being recommended outside of the annual budgeting process.
