

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Los Angeles Fire Department's readiness to deal with a multiyear drought event and related implications for wildfire risk in Los Angeles communities.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Krekorian – Rodriguez – Koretz):

1. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) to report on its readiness to deal with a multiyear drought event and related implications for wildfire risk in Los Angeles communities.
2. INSTRUCT the LAFD to report on best practices and citizens' responsibility to mitigate wildfire risk on private property.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY:

At a regular meeting held on October 20, 2021, the Public Safety Committee considered Motion (Krekorian - Rodriguez - Koretz) relative to requesting a report from the LAFD on its readiness to deal with a multiyear drought event and related implications for wildfire risk in Los Angeles communities.
