

ARTS, PARKS, HEALTH, EDUCATION, AND NEIGHBORHOODS COMMITTEE  
REPORT relative to the Fiscal Year 2021-22 annual plan for Trust Fund Expenditures  
for the Public Works Improvements Arts Program (PWIAP).

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE  
MAYOR:

1. APPROVE the FY 2021/22 Annual Plan for Expenditures for the PWIAP totaling \$2,082,037.
2. INSTRUCT the Department of Cultural Affairs (DCA) to expend the PWIAP funds available in the Arts and Cultural Facilities and Services Trust Fund No. 480, on approved public art projects and program administration.
3. AUTHORIZE the City Controller to approve the expenditures from the Arts and Cultural Facilities and Services Trust Fund No. 480, recommended by the DCA.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The DCA reports that there is no fiscal impact on the City's General Fund, as it relates to the report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On September 28, 2021, your Committee considered the September 9, 2021 DCA report relative to the Fiscal Year 2021-22 annual plan for Trust Fund Expenditures for the PWIAP.
