Summary: The South Robertson Neighborhoods Council supports this Motion (council file 21-1045) to request a report back from the Department of City Planning and Building on implementing SB 9 with specific provisions for affordable housing and community land trusts. According to a 2021 report, 499,430 low-income renter households in Los Angeles County do not have access to an affordable home. Any measures taken to increase the housing supply in Los Angeles should give priority to the creation of affordable units. We therefore support this request for a report from the Department of City Planning and Building on means for encouraging and facilitating the development of affordable housing in the implementation of SB 9 (Atkins), such as streamlining permitting processes for such projects.
