

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a proposed Second Amendment with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. to provide routine hazardous waste management services at various Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) facilities.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police, or designee, to execute a Second Amendment to Contract No. C-129868 with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. to continue to provide routine hazardous waste management services through June 30, 2023, contingent upon the confirmation of all required contractor compliance documents and the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that there is a General Fund impact of up to \$400,000 each year of the proposed two-year extension. Funding for the contract is available in the 2021-22 Adopted Budget. Subsequent year funding will be subject to consideration during the budget development process.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the recommendation in the subject CAO report, dated September 2, 2021, attached to the Council file, complies with the City Financial Policies in that the City's financial obligation is limited to funds budgeted for this purpose.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY:

At a regular meeting held on October 20, 2021, the Public Safety Committee considered a CAO report relative to a proposed Second Amendment with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. to provide routine hazardous waste management services at various LAPD facilities.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve on consent the CAO report. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
