

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a contract with Robles Farrier Services, Inc. to provide equine farrier services for the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) Metropolitan Division's Mounted Platoon.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police, or designee, to execute a contract with Robles Farrier Services, Inc. to provide equine farrier services for up to five years, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that there is no additional General Fund impact associated with the recommendation in the subject CAO report, dated September 15, 2021, attached to the Council file, as funding for the contract is available in the 2021-22 Adopted Budget. Funding for the contract in subsequent years will be determined as part of the annual budget development process.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the recommendation in the subject CAO report complies with the City Financial Policies in that the City's financial obligation is limited to funds budgeted for this purpose.

SUMMARY:

At a regular meeting held on October 20, 2021, the Public Safety Committee considered a CAO report relative to authority to execute a contract with Robles Farrier Services, Inc. to provide equine farrier services for the LAPD Metropolitan Division's Mounted Platoon for up to five years, consisting of an initial three-year agreement plus two optional one-year extensions.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve on consent the CAO report. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
