

ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the revised scope of work on the California Natural Resources Agency (CNRA) Environmental Enhancement and Mitigation (EEM) Program, for the Slauson Corridor, Making Connections Project; and grant amendments.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) to proceed with the revised, and CNRA approved scope of work on the Slauson Corridor, Making Connections Project, as detailed in the CNRA EEM Program grant amendment, included in the May 4, 2023, BOS report, attached to the Council file.
