

ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to developing a Building Decarbonization Work Plan for the City's existing building stock and identifying City facilities for near-term installation of Distributed Energy Generation Systems.

Recommendations for Council action:

2. INSTRUCT the negotiators to address pursuing an electric truck and identify other potential locations in high density areas to maximize the use of this specialty trucks.
