

**PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT** relative to the Fiscal Year 2021 (FY21) Intellectual Property Enforcement Grant Program (IPEGP).

Recommendations for Council action, **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:**

1. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police, or designee to:
  - a. Retroactively apply for and subsequently accept the grant award for the FY21 IPEGP in the amount of \$400,000 for the period of October 2, 2021 through September 30, 2023, from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Administration (BJA).
  - b. Negotiate and execute the grant award agreement, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.
2. AUTHORIZE the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) to:
  - a. Spend up to the total grant amount of \$400,000 in accordance with the grant award agreement.
  - b. Submit grant reimbursement requests to the grantor and deposit grant receipts in the LAPD Grant Fund No. 339/70.
  - c. Prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments as necessary to implement Mayor and Council intentions, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO); and' authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.
3. AUTHORIZE the Controller to:
  - a. Establish a grant receivable and appropriate \$400,000 to appropriation account, account number to be determined, within Fund No. 339/70, for the receipt and disbursement of the FY21 IPEGP grant funds.
  - b. Transfer appropriations for the FY21 IPEGP as needed from appropriation account, account number to be determined, in Fund No. 339/70, to Fund No. 100/70, account number and amount as follows:

Account No. 001090 Overtime, Civilian \$ 6,000
  - c. Transfer from Fund No. 339/70, appropriation account, account number to be determined, to Fund No. 100/12, account number and amount as follows:

Account No. 001010 Salaries, General \$ 15,072
4. INSTRUCT the City Clerk to:
  - a. Place the following action relative to the FY21 IPEGP grant on the Council agenda on July 1, 2022 or the first meeting day thereafter:
