Parking meters are used to help improve customer turnover in commercial areas by giving visitors sufficient time to shop and conduct other business while providing a time-based incentive to move their cars when they are done.

Vermont Avenue between West 77<sup>th</sup> Street and West 79<sup>th</sup> Street is a busy commercial corridor with a mix of small businesses, churches, and residential buildings. Currently, there is little on-street parking to accommodate the needs of the community. The installation of parking meters along this roadway segment could work effectively to provide parking access to patrons and visitors, while creating sufficient turnover for businesses. In order to install parking meters, it would be necessary to expand the existing Vermont-Manchester Parking Meter Zone.


