

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to expanding the existing Vermont-Manchester Parking Meter Zone to allow the installation of parking meters along the west side of Vermont Avenue between West 77th Street and West 79th Street.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant of Motion (Harris-Dawson – Bonin):

DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to report within 30 days on the feasibility and steps necessary to expand the existing Vermont-Manchester Parking Meter Zone to allow the installation of parking meters along the west side of Vermont Avenue between West 77th Street and West 79th Street.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On January 18, 2022, your Committee considered a Motion (Harris-Dawson – Bonin) relative to expanding the existing Vermont-Manchester Parking Meter Zone to allow the installation of parking meters along the west side of Vermont Avenue between West 77th Street and West 79th Street. According to the Motion, parking meters are used to help improve customer turnover in commercial areas by giving visitors sufficient time to shop and conduct other business while providing a time-based incentive to move their cars when they are done. Vermont Avenue between West 77th Street and West 79th Street is a busy commercial corridor with a mix of small businesses, churches, and residential buildings. Currently, there is little on-street parking to accommodate the needs of the community. The installation of parking meters along this roadway segment could work effectively to provide parking access to patrons and visitors, while creating sufficient turnover for businesses. In order to install parking meters, it would be necessary to expand the existing Vermont-Manchester Parking Meter Zone. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Motion as detailed in the above recommendations. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
