

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding AB 1594 (Ting) which would consider failure to comply with federal, state, or local law a public nuisance for members of the gun industry, holding them liable for any injury or death resulting from such failure to comply with applicable laws.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (O'Farrell - Krekorian), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2021-2022 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for AB 1594 (Ting), which would consider failure to comply with federal, state, or local law a public nuisance for members of the gun industry, holding them liable for any injury or death resulting from such failure to comply with applicable laws.
