The Board of the Studio City Neighborhood Council (SCNC) supports Council File 22-0002-S5: Title, AB 1603 (Salas) / Property Value / Grand Theft Threshold Decrease / Proposition 47. In 2004, California voters passed the Safe Neighborhoods and Schools Act, Prop. 47. We agree with Assemblymember Rudy Salas, D-Bakersfield, author of Assembly Bill 1603, which would lower the felony/misdemeanor threshold of Proposition 47 from \$950 to \$400. If passed, AB 1603 would bring that question to CA voters in the form of a ballot measure. Council File 22-0002-S5 shows support of AB 1603 by the City. We urge the City Council to pass, and our mayor to sign, the CF 22-0002-S5 resolution.
