Summary: CF 22-0051 2021 Officer Involved Shooting Incidents / Investigations / Los Angeles Police Department Use of Force Policy Racial & Social Justice Committee Recommends Palms NC Support or Oppose CF: Support CIS: The Palms Neighborhood Council is in favor of this council file, and believes that this report should be done in perpetuity compared against previous years. Motion 1/12/2022: Requires LAPD to produce a report on all Officer Involved Shooting incidents in 2021, including the status, timeline, and findings of non-compliance with the LAPD's Use of Force Policy as compared to findings for the previous five years. CF Summary: On December 23, 2021, a man entered a Burlington Coat Factory store in North Hollywood and proceeded to randomly assault customers. LAPD responded to the incident after receiving multiple reports of the assaults. Officers arrived at the scene and after confronting the suspect, opened fire. A stray bullet fatally struck a 14-year-old Valentina Orellana-Peralta, who was in a dressing room at the scene. This incident is one of several Officer Involved Shootings in the City within the past few years. Each Officer Involved Shooting is investigated by the Force Investigation Division and the Office of the Inspector General for compliance with the LAPD's Use of Force Policies. Several of these investigations remain pending, so the Department should provide an update on the status of investigations opened in 2021, as well as a five-year comparative analysis.
