MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations in order to effect settlement in the case entitled Gregory Randall v. City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. BC716749. (This matter arises from a complaint of failure to reasonably accommodate, failure to engage in the interactive process and failure to prevent harassment, discrimination and retaliation in violation of the California Fair Employment & Housing Act (FEHA) against the City.), **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:**

1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney’s Office and Department of Animal Services to expend up to **\$275,000** in settlement of the above-entitled matter.
2. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to draw a demand from Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009798, Miscellaneous Liability Payouts, as follows: Scolinos, Sheldon & Nevell LLP and Gregory Randall in the amount of \$215,000.
3. AUTHORIZE the Department of Animal Services to draw a demand from Fund No. 100/06, Account No. 001010, Salaries General, payable to Gregory Randall for back wages in the amount of \$60,000, subject to all applicable payroll withholdings.
4. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to make necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer, and AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

This matter was recommended for approval by the Budget and Finance Committee (Krekorian – Blumenfield – De León – Rodriguez: “Yes”) at its meeting held on April 11, 2022, in Closed Session as permitted by Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(1).
