

BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the below market sale of one 1996 Lime Seagrave Triple Engine to El Camino College's Fire Academy.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Lee – Rodriguez):

1. FIND that the El Camino College's Fire Academy is eligible to purchase one 1996 Lime Seagrave Triple Engine (Vehicle Identification Number 1F9EC28TXTCST2098) at below market value (\$1.00) in accordance with the Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 22.547 (Donation of Surplus City Equipment).
2. REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare a contract to effectuate the sale and transfer of the above-identified surplus equipment at below market value to El Camino College Fire Academy as expeditiously as possible.
3. INSTRUCT the City Clerk to inform the Fire Academy [Chief Jeffrey Baumunk, Public Safety Director, (310) 660-3593 x3256, 206 West Beach Avenue, Industry & Tech building, Room 231, Inglewood, California 90302] that the surplus equipment must be claimed within 90 days from the date of Council approval of the request after which time it will revert to the City's surplus equipment pool for disposal by the Department of General Services.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
