

BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to adding resolution authority and six-months funding for one Deputy City Attorney III to assist the Civil, Human Rights, and Equity Department's Discrimination Enforcement Division.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR, pursuant to Motion (Price – Wesson):

1. APPROVE resolution authority for one Deputy City Attorney III without funding.
2. INSTRUCT the City Attorney's Office to work with the City Administrative Officer (CAO) to adjust any shortfalls in the department's salary account through the Financial Status Report (FSR) process.

SUMMARY

At its special meeting held on June 27, 2022, the Budget and Finance Committee considered Motion (Price - Wesson) relative to adding resolution authority and six-months funding for one Deputy City Attorney III to assist the Civil, Human Rights, and Equity Department's Discrimination Enforcement Division.

After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the motion as amended to remove funding and to work with the CAO to adjust shortfalls through the FSR process. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
