

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to outlining a program for a temporary homelessness shelter agreement at the Cecil Hotel located at 640 South Main Street in Council District 14.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (De León - Blumenfield):

DIRECT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the Los Angeles Housing Department, the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority, the General Services Department and other City Departments as needed, to provide a report outlining options for master leasing, or using other contracting mechanisms as needed, the Cecil Hotel in order to provide a pathway to permanent housing for homeless individuals in the City.
