DISCUSSION

This donation will be utilized to fund approximately 60 hours of multi-engine airplane flight training. The training is for the four Air Support Division’s (ASD) command pilots currently in training to fly the Department’s King Air. This training is expected to be completed over the next twelve months and ASD will maintain a record of all receipts for audit purposes.

This donation is valued at \$29,640.00. The donor, Air Support Angels Foundation, made one donation to the Department in 2021 valued at \$15,400.00; two donations in 2020 valued at \$16,908.00; and two donations in 2019 valued at \$17,021.40.
