Honorable City Council Members and Homeless and Poverty Committee Members,

The Pico Union Neighborhood Council (PUNC) at its Regular General Board on September 7, 2022, voted on agenda item 5 (n), 10 yes, 0 no, 0 abstaining in favor of requiring L.A. Homeless Service Authority (LAHSA) to release monthly reports for 1 year following place-based intervention.

We are in agreement and in support of the motion presented by Councilmember Mike Bonin that data-driven information must be used to identify best practices for our unhoused population. LAHSA's place interventions continue throughout the city with minimal reporting of data with regards to long term placement outcomes of homeless individuals. Therefore, information is scarce as to whether the system in place is working or not while numerous resources and departments continue to be utilized in support of LAHSA.

Accountability and reports are crucial and necessary to ensure that our unhoused population is benefiting from the services provided by LAHSA.
