

ARTS, PARKS, HEALTH, EDUCATION, AND NEIGHBORHOODS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the initial costs of providing automated external defibrillators (AED) at every Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) facility, and related matters.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Krekorian – O ‘Farrell):

1. INSTRUCT the RAP, with assistance from the Los Angeles Fire Department and the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), to report on the total number and location of AED’s at RAP facilities, the record of utilization of AED’s at RAP facilities, and a plan for implementing AED’s at every RAP facility in the City.
2. INSTRUCT the RAP, with assistance from the CLA, and City Administrative Officer (CAO), to report on the initial costs of providing AED’s at every RAP facility, life-cycle costs, maintenance costs, infrastructure costs, and any additional information that may be necessary for Council to consider to evaluate, and appropriate the funds necessary to implement the plan.
