ADOPT the election ordinance and ballot resolutions to submit the proposed initiative ordinance, without alteration, to a vote of the electors of the City at the next regular City or Statewide election conducted by the County of Los Angeles to be held more than 110 days from the date of Council action (the November 8, 2022 election).

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Clerk reports that there is zero to minimal cost for adopting either recommendation in this report, assuming there will be a Citywide race or a moderate number of Council-sponsored measures on the November ballot.
