Summary: Dear Councilmember Blumenfield, The Reseda Neighborhood Council requests a U-Turn must yield to right turn sign be placed on Sherman Way at Geysers Avenue at the eastbound left turn lane. The increased traffic brought by the opening of the car wash has caused an increase in u-turns at that intersection. Cars seeking to make a right turn lane from Geysers onto Sherman Way as they exit the car wash or from the neighborhoods are increasingly competing with drivers seeking to make u-turns from Sherman Way. Constituents and members of our council have noted the increased risk at this intersection. We believe an analysis of traffic accidents at this intersection will also show the need for the U-Turn must yield to right turn sign. We also believe that the addition of a crosswalk at this intersection would be well placed as it would connect two residential neighborhoods and increase pedestrian safety along this commercial corridor.
