NON-EXCLUSIVE UTILITY EASEMENT TO AT&T**

Honorable Members:

This Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance would authorize the City of Los Angeles to enter into and grant to Pacific Bell Telephone Company, a California corporation, dba AT&T (Grantee) a non-exclusive Agreement and Grant of Utility Easement [AT&T]. The foregoing is in furtherance of the public purpose of the Landside Access Modernization Program at Los Angeles International Airport (Airport), is in support of aviation at the Airport, and is in the best interests of the public.

The subject Agreement and Grant of Utility Easement [AT&T] provides replacement rights for continued operations after recordation of Tentative Tract Map 74322, which will merge public rights-of-way into private land. It is in exchange for good and valuable consideration, including Grantee's affirmative consent and agreement to recordation of Tentative Tract Map 74322.
