## MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations in order to effect settlement in the case entitled Harel Raz v. County of Los Angeles, et al., Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 19STCV22291. (This matter arises from a fall due to an uplifted sidewalk located in front of 1670 Veteran Avenue.), **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:**

1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney's Office to expend up to **\$750,000** in settlement of the above-entitled matter.
2. AUTHORIZE the Controller's Office to transfer \$750,000 from the Liability Claims Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009798, Miscellaneous Liability Payouts, to Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009795, Public Works, Street Services Liability Payouts.
3. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to draw a demand from Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009795, Public Works, Street Services Liability Payouts, as follows: Ardalan & Associates, PLC and Rafael Raz, Guardian Ad Litem for Harel Raz in the amount of \$750,000.
4. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to make necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer, and authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.
