Summary: The Bel Air-Beverly Crest Neighborhood Council, at a publicly-noticed board meeting held on November 16, 2022, voted to oppose the IKE contract and program described in CF 22-1154 for the following reasons: • No environmental review process (CEQA review) • No financial analysis (CLA or CAO review) • No competitive procurement process/No RFP issued • Inappropriate reliance on a competitive bid process undertaken by Houston, Texas rather than by City of Los Angeles • No public health review • No traffic/public safety analysis related to digital signage and driver distraction • Violates the City Charter by bypassing the City Planning Commission • Privacy right violations – data capture from those passing • May undermine City authority to regulate all billboards/off-site signage
