Robert Ramirez was raised in the northeast area of Los Angeles where he remains today. He was first hired as an Electrician Apprentice by Southern Pacific Railroad in 1963. Two years later, he left to serve in the military (Air Force) for four years. After his service, he returned to work for Southern Pacific at Taylor Yard as an Electrician and was soon promoted to Senior Electrical Instructor.

In 1988, Robert was elected as General Chairman of the Electrical Workers, the first Latino in this post, where he became heavily involved in negotiations with Union Pacific Railroad that ultimately led to the closing of Taylor Yard and moved its local electricians to Colton, City of Commerce, and Long Beach.

Though he retired from the railroads in 2005, Robert continues to be employed as an Associate Professor in the Community College District. Back in 1968 Robert married Caroline, the daughter of a Railroad Machinist, Raymond Valencia. They have two children and 4 fantastic grandchildren.

Dear Mr. Ramirez:

I am pleased to inform you that I hereby appoint you to the Rent Adjustment Commission for the term ending May 20, 2026. Should this apply to your Commission, you will be receiving a packet from the City Ethics Commission containing information about the City's conflict of interest laws, and a copy of the State Form 700/Statement of Economic Interests. You are required to complete and return this form **within 21 days** of your nomination to the City Ethics Commission at 200 North Spring Street, City Hall, 24th Floor, Los Angeles, California 90012.
