MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations in order to effect settlement in the case entitled Evangeline Morse v. California Department of Transportation, et al., Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 19STCV08392. (This matter arises from a trip and fall incident that occurred on April 21, 2018, on a sidewalk in the 7700 block of Royer Avenue.), **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:**

1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney's Office to expend up to **\$250,000** in settlement of the above-entitled matter.
2. AUTHORIZE the Controller's Office to transfer \$250,000 from the Liability Claims Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009798, Miscellaneous Liability Payouts, to Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009795, Public Works, Street Services Liability Payouts.
3. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to draw a demand from Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009795, Public Works, Street Services Liability Payouts, as follows: Vaziri Law Group, APC and Evangeline Morse in the amount of \$250,000.
4. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to make necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer, and authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.
