We declare that on November 1, 2022, a Brown Act noticed public meeting was held by the Eagle Rock Neighborhood Council (ERNC) at which a quorum was present. The following motion passed with a unanimous vote:

The Eagle Rock Neighborhood Council supports the Council requesting that the Chief Legislative Analyst and the City Attorney report with recommendations that amend the Rules of the City Council to include a list of potential consequences that can be imposed upon a censured Councilmember, including but not limited to, the following:

- Limiting a censured Councilmember's ability to use discretionary funds and authorize contracts;
- Restricting a censured Councilmember's participation in Council Committees until the end of their term, or until the Council overturns their censure; and
- Limiting a censured Councilmember's ability to introduce certain types of Motions.

The ERNC supports the Council requesting that the City Attorney report with recommendations that amend the City Charter as it relates to censure.
