TO CITY CLERK FOR PLACEMENT ON NEXT

The San Fernando Valley is prone to widespread fires. Council District Seven is home to a large equine-keeping population that could be significantly impacted by future fires. When disaster strikes, being prepared for an evacuation for residents of these areas can require specific equipment. In the Adopted 2022-2023 Fiscal Year Budget, funding for the purchase of three horse evacuation trailers was provided for the Emergency Management Department. The new trailers would be integral in improving the speed and capacity of equine emergency evacuations.

**I THEREFORE MOVE**, subject to the approval of the Mayor, to authorize the Controller to transfer \$200,000 from the Unappropriated Balance, Fund 100/58, Horse Evacuation Trailers Account, No. 580382 be transferred/appropriated to the Animal Services Department Fund, No. 100-06 668270553.
