

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to traffic calming measures and safety improvements to Anaheim Street between Figueroa Street and Henry Ford Avenue.

Recommendation for Council action:

RECEIVE and FILE the June 7, 2023 Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) report, inasmuch as this report is for information only and no Council action is required.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On June 14, 2023, your Committee considered a June 7, 2023 LADOT report relative to traffic calming measures and safety improvements to Anaheim Street between Figueroa Street and Henry Ford Avenue. According to the LADOT, to improve safety by advancing elements of the City's Active Transportation Program (ATP)-awarded project on Anaheim, the quick-build safety project from Figueroa Street to Alameda Street includes new street designs as well as new parking, curb extensions, and new intersection treatments to improve safety and connectivity for bicyclists. The LADOT has collected pre-project data, and will begin its project evaluation in 2024 after collecting at least one year of post-project data. Future phases of the project will implement these treatments with concrete, and will include new traffic signals and pedestrian crossings. A detailed overview of the specific street improvements is included in the LADOT report. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to note and file the LADOT report. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
