Summary: The Board of the Studio City Neighborhood Council (SCNC) supports Council File 22-1594. After a deluge of complaints from Los Angeles residents about the proliferation of immobile and unsafe recreational and oversized vehicles in the City, the Board of Transportation Commissioners recently investigated the chronic problem. The Transportation Commissioners found that there was an increase in crime on impacted streets, enhanced risk of fires, illegal drug use, dumping of trash, and blocking of cyclists. Offending Recreational Vehicles (RVs) and oversized vehicles were also not being cited by authorities. The Commission drafted a report with recommendations for the City Council to implement. These important recommendations include: (1) Begin immediate parking enforcement of oversized vehicles in violation of LAMC Sections 80.69.4 and 80.69. (2) Request that the Mayor declare an emergency regarding the proliferation of these vehicles so that the impacted streets can be immediately cleared. (3) Immediately install parking restriction signage in impacted areas. (4) Adopt a citywide ordinance prohibiting oversized vehicles in all residential-zoned areas, like many municipalities have done across the U.S. The Board supports these common-sense recommendations for immediate action that will bring order to chaotic areas that have become drug dens, hubs of criminal activity, and sources of environmental pollution and public health hazards.

After a deluge of complaints from Los Angeles residents about the proliferation of immobile and unsafe recreational and oversized vehicles in the City, the Board of Transportation Commissioners recently investigated the chronic problem. The Transportation Commissioners found that there was an increase in crime on impacted streets, enhanced risk of fires, illegal drug use, dumping of trash, and blocking of cyclists. Offending Recreational Vehicles (RVs) and oversized vehicles were also not being cited by authorities. The Commission drafted a report with recommendations for the City Council to implement. These important recommendations include:

- (1) Begin immediate parking enforcement of oversized vehicles in violation of LAMC Sections 80.69.4 and 80.69.
- (2) Request that the Mayor declare an emergency regarding the proliferation of these vehicles so that the impacted streets can be immediately cleared.
- (3) Immediately install parking restriction signage in impacted areas.
- (4) Adopt a citywide ordinance prohibiting oversized vehicles in **all** residential-zoned areas, like many municipalities have done across the U.S.

The Board supports these common-sense recommendations for immediate action that will bring order to chaotic areas that have become drug dens, hubs of criminal activity, and sources of environmental pollution and public health hazards.
