Summary: At a regular public meeting on May 9, 2023, the Board of Directors of the Downtown Los Angeles Neighborhood Council (“DLANC”) voted to submit this Community Impact Statement against unless amended of CF 22-1594 - Hazardous and Illegal RV Parking / Resident Complaints / Oversized Vehicles / Parking Enforcement. DLANC is generally in support of the premise of the City addressing the concentration of RVs and oversized vehicles in sensitive areas as a whole. However, we are strongly concerned that this report from the BOTC falls short of addressing the unintended impacts of RV and vehicle dwelling in underserved and equity-focused communities. Any action from the City Council and BOTC should include outreach efforts as the primary model prior to parking enforcement or citation. In addition, the City Council and the BOTC, in partnership with LAHSA and other social service providers, should investigate the expansion of safe parking sites and other interim solutions for displaced vehicle dwellers before the implementation of a city-wide enforcement campaign.
